To live so that others will become disciples of Jesus Christ for the transformation of the world.

Have you ever had one of those days, or perhaps weeks, when it felt like you were waiting "for the other shoe to drop" as the old saying goes. I know I have felt that sense of anxiety so many times in my life. I imagine the disciples felt that way when

they watched one of their "own" betray Jesus. In a flash, Jesus was taken away and they begin to scatter. As they hid out in fear and, I suspect, a certain degree of disbelief, they must have wondered what was going to happen next. Surely, Jesus could get out of this situation. He had just raised Lazarus from the dead. He had performed miracle after miracle. Escaping a group of soldiers should be easy; but that did not happen. What was going to happen next?

Over the past three months, since the Special General Conference within The United Methodist Church was held, I have heard from so many of you asking what is going to happen next. We have talked, emailed, chatted over coffee and cried together, and I am honored that you have invited me into these sacred moments of conversation.

Westlake UMC is in the unique position of being one of the larger churches in our Conference. As such, we truly have diversity of thought on many issues including those relating to human sexuality. It is far easier to turn inward and only surround yourself with those who think the same as you on issues than it is to truly be a welcoming and inclusive church for all people. However, I am convinced if we stay open, it is through this diversity that we can hear God speaking as we continue to grow to be more Christlike and continue to serve as the hands and feet of Christ in a hurting world.

What is next for The United Methodist Church?

So, what is going to happen next? The short answer is no one knows for sure. We know that the parts of the Traditional Plan that were found to be constitutional go into effect in the United States on January 1, 2020. We know that many parts of the plan were found to be unconstitutional. There is a chart on our church website under the Being United Methodist tab (under "About Us") that outlines the ruling of the Judicial Council. Other than that, we are in a season of waiting and working as our denomination prepares for our next regularly scheduled General Conference (GC) which will be held in May 2020. There is much work being done in preparation for GC 2020. Like many of you, I am prayerfully wrestling to come to peace with the decisions made at the Special General Conference. For me, peace does not mean agreement or disagreement. Peace does not mean inaction or action. Peace to me means being able to sit in the midst and be attune to what God is doing.

I firmly believe that God is at work within our own lives, the life of Westlake UMC, and within our world-wide

denomination. God was at work during those dark, frightening hours when Jesus was dying on the cross and was laid in the tomb. Why would we believe God stopped working at the resurrection?

I see God working in our denomination with a meeting being held at the United Methodist Church of the Resurrection in Kansas in late May. All general secretaries of The United Methodist Church, all active Bishops within the United States, and ten individuals from each of the fifty-four annual conferences in the United States have been invited to gather to discern a direction especially for centrists and progressive churches, like our church, within the denomination. I suspect this will be just the beginning of the work that will be done leading up to GC 2020. In June, the East Ohio Annual Conference will elect delegates to GC 2020. That delegation will begin meeting as well.

What is next at Westlake UMC?

While there is work being done within our denomination to discern what is next for The United Methodist Church, there is still much work for each of us to do in the local church. I know many of you are upset, fearful, angry and hurt by the decisions of Special General Conference. In the midst of all of those emotions, I am sincerely and prayerfully asking you to stay engaged in the life of Westlake UMC. As the hands and feet of Christ in this world there is still much work for us to do together. I encourage you to go the extra mile to engage in mission and outreach knowing that answers to our own concerns can often be found in serving others. I pray that you will continue to give generously to God through the ministries of this church of your gifts of time and financial resources as we stay faithful in doing what we know God has called us to do on the westside of Cleveland and beyond.

While I cannot with certainty tell you what will come next for our denomination over the next twelve months, I can tell you that Westlake UMC will continue to be a church that lives out its identity and values of welcoming all people.

In June we will restart Vacation Bible School at our Simpson Metro West (SMW) Campus. Staff and adult volunteers from both campus and our Bread on Bridge worship will come together to tell the stories of Jesus to young children from the SMW community. This next generation of followers of Jesus Christ will be fed both spiritually and physically as the children will receive a nutritious lunch every day during VBS. Summers are especially challenging for school-age children with food insecurity. During the school year they receive meals at school, but during the

summer those resources are not available. Next, youth from both of our campuses and from North Olmsted UMC will travel to Detroit on a United Methodist Volunteers in Mission trip to serve at Cass Community Services. Adults will participate in our third annual adult mission trip to Blue Rose Mission in Mansfield. We will continue to have passionate worship services each week, time for prayer and opportunities to grow in relationship with God through small groups. There is a lot happening next at Westlake UMC, and I hope you will continue to be a part of these life-changing and life-giving ministries.

What is next for you?

As we wait, as we sit in the midst of where we are as a denomination, I invite you to stay open to the movement of God. Come together as a diverse faith community to worship God and serve God as we know God calls us to do. I am honored to continue to walk with all of you, wherever you may be on the issue of human sexuality. I firmly believe God is doing a new thing within our denomination. Let us be active in our waiting, continuing to be a loving and faithful church that is seeking to do God's will as we live our lives so that others will want to be followers of Jesus Christ. We may not, in this moment, know precisely what is next for The United Methodist Church, but it will be revealed in time and I want to be a part of that with each of you.
