


## What Kind of Christmas?

The season of Advent is upon us and Christmas day is growing near. 2019 has been a year in the life of this church filled with many occasions of personal and collective reflection. It has been a busy year filled with this church sharing with others in tangible ways the love and grace of Jesus Christ. Now, as we approach Christmas, I think it is the time for each of us to ask ourselves what kind of Christmas do we intend to celebrate.

We have many different small groups this year studying, Almost Christmas: A Wesleyan Advent Experience.
Throughout the study we are focused on the peace, hope, love, and joy that comes from a relationship with Jesus Christ. The study uses the famous John Wesley sermon from 1741, "The Almost Christian" as a guide for living an "altogether Christmas" as an "altogether Christian." In his sermon, "The Almost Christian," John Wesley challenges us all to become "altogether a Christian" first by fully loving God. The second attribute of being "altogether a Christian" is to fully love others. Finally, the "altogether Christian" will have full trust and confidence in God.

Wesley's closing words in his sermon, "The Almost Christian" are still relevant today. He wrote, "May we

all thus experience what it is to be, not almost only; but altogether Christians; being justified freely by his grace, through the redemption that is in Jesus; knowing we have peace with God through Jesus Christ; rejoicing in hope of the glory of God; and having the love of God shed abroad in our hearts, by the Holy Ghost given unto us!" Wesley reminds us that when we seek to be an "altogether Christian" we come to fully know the peace, the hope, the joy, and the love of God that comes from a deep relationship with Jesus Christ.
We live in a world that is filled with the superficial. Wesley calls us to a deeper relationship with God. There is no better time to begin cultivating that deeper,
